Specific Role and Requirements

- Fulfil a commitment of weekly delivery to schools as detailed by Artis (normally 36 deliveries per school per academic year) further to an initial school introductory visit
- Plan sessions, progression and achievement in close liaison with schools, keeping written plans and other records as required by Artis, and provide copies to schools (one copy to be left in the Artis Communications File) of weekly session plans on a weekly basis.
- Ensure effective delivery of the Artis Curriculum to whole classes by employing appropriate and successful classroom management and behaviour management strategies
- Be aware of and provide feedback with regard to the individual needs of pupils, by liaising with heads, teachers and teaching assistants in schools on a regular basis
- Ensure all children participate in performance opportunities (at least once per term per school)
- Write annual class reports for each class, commenting on progress and achievement
- Attend and participate in all Artis Training and Development sessions provided
- Undertake two peer observations per academic year
- Have and continue to update a wide and thorough knowledge of performing arts teaching and in particular of the Artis Curriculum
- Contribute to the continuing Artis Curriculum development and to share delivery materials with Artis colleagues
- Arrange sick cover, if required, in line with the Artis Sick Cover Procedure
- Practice and uphold the policies and requirements of Artis
